

Brief Information of the Ministry:

Introduction:

The Mission school set up by the Welsh Missionary in the year 1907 at Kenareram (now Melangpeuram village). Through the establishment of the Mission school the gospel was spread among the Zeme Naga community. In the year 1910, Shri. Dituing Pame was seriously sick and through his sickness he was converted into Christianity. The number of Christianity became to increase among the Zeme Naga community and thereafter, with the enlargement of Christianity the "ZEME PRESBYTERY" was created from "CACHAR HILL TRIBES SYNOD" (Presbyterian Church of India) in the year 1956. And later, "NREIBAK PRESBYTERY" was bifurcated from "ZEME PRESBYTERY" in the year 1994 for suitable church administration and its operation.

Children Ministry:

The Sunday school began in the Zeme Community when the church started its growth. In the early days, the Sunday school classes were taught by the Mission School Teachers and Preachers by taking its responsibilities a part from their missionary duties. At present, the Sunday school was well-organized by the Church

itself and set up various classes. For example, Adult class i.e. written & oral, Senior, Intermediate, Junior, Primary and Infant Class.

In the Sunday school classes, the prescribe text has been given for all classes. Music and moral discipline were taught in the Sunday school classes. Further, the Sunday Committee organized teacher's training in the presbytery level.

Apart from this, the Church has set up different committees for the welfare of the children like- Sunday School Children Conference, Vocational Bible School and Children Bible Club. These committees organized and conducted a program in the pastorates and Mission Schools in various places.

The Church carries out the Children Ministry mainly on Sunday school in our local Churches. Churches in this area needed systematic or methodical teaching for the children. To train in accordance with the stages of growth for the promotion of emotional, spiritual and physical life of the children. The duty of the Church is to develop the policy and **“to train a child where and which way He/She should proceed”**. Therefore, in order to fulfill the duty and responsibility of the church we approach Compassion East India.

Presbyterian Youth Fellowship (PYF) Ministry:

The PYF is one of the wings of the 'Nreibak Presbytery. The youth department is actively working outside and within the Presbytery through Mission & Evangelism, Musical, Gospel Campaign, Crusade and Seminar etc. The youth

wing has separate office comprises of Leader, Assistant, Secretary Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, and Statistician. The Leader is appointed by the Church Court.

Presbyterian Women Fellowship (PWF) Ministry:

The Presbyterian Women Fellowship (PWF) is also the wings of the 'Nreibak Presbytery. The PWF extended the holistic ministry through preaching the gospel to the other faiths. The PWF support a missionary. The PWF has organized Annual Session.

Social Ministry:

Community Resource Management Services CRMS has been working under the banner of the 'Nreibak Presbytery through its sub-committee the so-called TRUST COMMITTEE. The project activity has been implemented in cooperation with the Executive Members of the CRMS.
